



Dan Hipple presented a talk or discussion of his experience in **Building a Set of Mint State Peace Dollars**. Most of the discussion was around the issue of the various grading services, their significant differences in grading and grade consistency, and the possibility of buying MS coins from some of the less consistent services at reduced prices, particularly online to obtain them at realistic prices for the actual quality of the coin rather than marked grade.

Dan brought his collection of slabbed Peace Dollars to illustrate these points.

The passing of former PCNS President O.L. Wallis was announced to those present.

### ***Raffle:***

The raffle was held, featuring Herb's specially prepared packets which paired numismatic books and catalogs with tokens and medals of related topics.
