OCTOBER PROGRAM REPORT — *Numismatic Books*

Members presented and explained their choices of titles they found particularly worthwhile for their own use.

Mark: *WWII Remembered: history in your hands—a numismatic study*, his most-used reference, co-authored by Schwan and Boling, which has 2 indices to help him quickly find any WWII-related material.

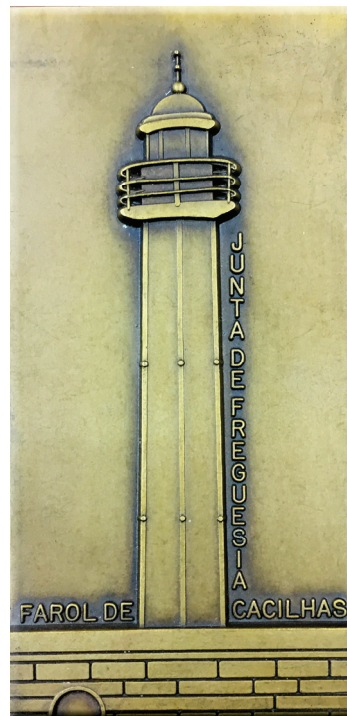
Jason: *From Mine to Mint*, a manual on the mining, refining, and minting process by Roger W. Burdette. Also a reprint edition of R.S. Yeoman's 1947 *Redbook*, where he can check out historic coin values. He also brought a copy of the 2017 edition of *Mega Red*, a major tome on US coinage and medals from the Redbook publisher.

Bill: several titles on medieval French coinages in aid of his collection of Tête Chinonaise deniers: D. Legros, *Monnaie Féodales Françaises*; F. Dumas, *Le Trésor de Fécamp*; and S. Michon, *Les Monnaies Fédiales Bléso-Chartraines*.

Stephen: his most used Roman names dictionary, Bowder's *Who was Who in the Roman World*; and his favorite one-volume resource on medieval numismatics, Philip Grierson's *Coins of Medieval Europe* (Seaby 1991).

Bob: his 2 main books on medals: Swoger's *National*

Commemorative Medals of the United States of America since 1973; Dean's *National Commemorative Medals of the United States Mint*. Also a couple of works on other US material: Tucker's *American Gold and Silver*, on US Mint collectors' issues; and a museum book on *Peace Medals — negotiating power in early America*.



OCTOBER EXHIBITS

Ed brought some lighthouse medals from his collection, a silver and bronze medal for the January 14, 1928 inauguration of the lighthouse of *Ferro Carrila a Rocha*, and a medallion plaque for the lighthouse at *Junta de Freguesia*.
